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
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


## **SureWall**

### Installation Instructions




Plan and measure the length and height of the wall then mark and dig post holes.



Using a string line, ensure the retaining wall is straight and level before concreting the posts into the ground, then check that the required wall height has been achieved and that posts line up and are vertical. Also ensure the first rail is embedded 50mm in to the ground.



Cut timber rails to length before slotting them into the SureWall retaining posts. Prior to back filling, suitable drainage is recommended, i.e. slotted drainage pipe with FilterSleeve® laid in a trench of drainage metal, additionally the drainage metal can be wrapped in a DuraForce® or FilterPlus® geotextile.



Nail down timber capping (optional), backfill up to the wall and you're done!

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
